

ROMANTIC ROAD

An independent 6-day tour exploring Western Bavaria.
The Romantic Road (Romantische Strasse) links a series of picturesque Bavarian towns and cities from Wuerzburg south towards the Alps.



Itinerary

Day 1: Wuerzburg

Arrival to Wuerzburg by own arrangements. Find the documentation for the tour upon check in at hotel. Overnight at Hotel Regina or similar.

Day 2: Wuerzburg - Tauberbischofsheim (B)

After breakfast don't forget - also on the following days of the tour - to leave your luggage at the reception desk until 09.00 am - it will be picked up during the day and brought to the next destination. Departure from Wuerzburg following the Romantic Road, passing by small, historical villages and beautiful landscapes before you arrive at Tauberbischofsheim. Visit the neogothic Town Hall with its „Glocken-spiel" located on the market square & the town's landmark the „Tuermer's Tower". Overnight at Am Schloß o. s.

Day 3: Tauberbischofsheim - Bad Mergentheim - Weikersheim (B)

Through the wonderful Tauber-Valley you will reach the city of Bad Mergentheim, former residence of the German Grand Masters of the Order of Teutonic Knights and nowadays a well known spa-resort. At Weikersheim, where we will stay overnight, you will find one of the finest Renaissance Palaces, surrounded by magnificent gardens in Versailles style. Overnight at Hotel Grüner Hof o.s..

Day 4: Weikersheim – Creglingen – Rothenburg o.d. Tauber (B)

A must for visitors of the Romantic Road is the altar to St. Mary by Tilman Riemenschneider in the Church of Our Lord and the Thimble Museum across the road. Nature can be explored in the "Muensterseen" park. On to Rothenburg o.d. Tauber, the medieval jewel of Germany, where in the evening you can join the city walk with the Night Watchman. Overnight at Hotel Spitzweg o.s..

Day 5: Rothenburg – Schillingsfürst – Feuchtwangen - Dinkelsbühl (B)

In the morning we are leaving for Schillingsfürst, whose landmark is the Baroque castle of the Princes of Hohenlohe-Schillingsfürst. Next stop is at Feuchtwangen, the city where the Court of a Franconian King and a Benedictine Monastery founded in the 8th century. It is just a short ride to Dinkelsbühl, surrounded by ancient town walls which you will explore when you accompany the Night Watchman in the evening. Overnight at Hotel Blauer Hecht or similar.

Day 6: Dinkelsbühl (B)

Time in the morning for own activities before you will board our coach on the Romantic Road who will bring you and your bicycles back to Wuerzburg. Arrival in the late afternoon / evening.

Services included

In General:

- Five nights at specially selected tourist superior and tourist hotels including tax and service charges. All rooms with private bath or shower and toilet.
- Luggage transportation from hotel to hotel
- Transportation by modern coaches with AC/WC incl. bicycles from Dinkelsbuehl to Wuerzburg
