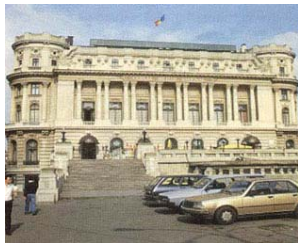


BUCHAREST SIGHTSEEING

Half day sightseeing 3 ½ hours

Get acquainted with the Romanian capital, once nicknamed "Little Paris". During the tour you will visit the House of People, the second largest building in the world after the Pentagon and the open air Village Museum. Listen how the Romanian people finally succeeded to topple the last communist dictator in eastern Europe in the Revolution Square. Your tour will bring you also to the Romanian Atheneum, the Opera House, the National Military Club, the Military Academy and the Triumphal Arch.

Full day sightseeing 6 hours

Get acquainted with the Romanian capital, once nicknamed "Little Paris". During the tour you will visit the House of People, the second largest building in the world after the Pentagon, the open air Village Museum and the National treasury at the History Museum, a fascinating collection of gold objects from the Neolithic to the modern Romanian Crown jewellery. Listen how the Romanian people finally succeeded to topple the last communist dictator in eastern Europe in the Revolution Square. Visit one of the local picturesque farmers markets and try some of the very fresh products. Your tour will bring you also to the Romanian Athenaeum, the Opera House, the National Military Club, the Military Academy and the Triumphal Arch.

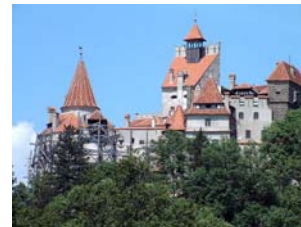

Dracula's Castle 10 hours

From Royal Palaces to Gothic Castles

During this day trip you will get to visit some of the most interesting and famous Romanian Sites. After an early departure, you drive through the scenic Prahova Valley until you reach one of the most popular mountain and ski resorts in the Carpathians - Sinaia - the favourite place of King Carol 1st of Hohenzollern Sigmaringen, the first king of Romania. Here you will visit the splendid Peles Castle, former summer residence of the Romanian Royal Family, and the Sinaia monastery erected at the end of the 17th century, the oldest building in town. Continue your tour to Brasov, one of the most important towns of the area during the middle ages. Here you will visit the Black Church (closed on Sunday), largest gothic building in South Eastern Europe, which houses a collection of unique oriental carpets. You will also visit the St. Nicholas church and the First Romanian School in Transilvania. After lunch at local restaurant drive to Bran village and visit the famous Dracula's castle, build in the 14th century on a 60m high rock by the merchants of Brasov, in order to protect the border between Transilvania and Wallachia. After a hunt for Dracula's souvenirs in the local market drive back to Bucharest.

Highlights: Sinaia Monastery (o), Peles Castle (o)/ Sinaia, Dracula Castle (o)/ Bran, Black Church (o) / Brasov, plus many other places of interest.
