LOCH NESS AND INVERNESS 2 DAY TOUR

Departs 09.30 **Returns 19.30 (Edinburgh)**
Departure days: Tuesdays, Thursdays & Saturdays All Year)
Accommodation options: B&B ensuite or Hotel (minimum 3 stars)

A 2 DAY ESCAPE EXPLORING LOCH NESS, A NIGHT OUT IN INVERNESS AND REJUVENATING IN THE MAJESTY OF THE GLEN AFFRIC WILDERNESS.

Highlights of the tour include the wilderness of Glencoe, steeped in its grim history, where you can soak up the atmosphere during an afternoon walk.

Continuing north and up the Great Glen to Loch Ness we travel the whole 23 miles of the famous Loch - plenty of time to try and spot "Nessie!" We arrive at our destination of Inverness where you will be dropped off at your accommodation. The evening is free for you to explore the capital of the Highlands.



The 2nd day's highlights include a visit to Glen Affric with scenery that takes you back 500 years in time to the glory of Scotland's Caledonian Pine Forest. This is a very beautiful and unique area, being one of the last remaining pockets of native Forest left standing. We spend some time here to enjoy a walk alongside the River Affric.

After all that fresh air, we head across to Loch Ness for lunch, and a chance to relax in the small, charming village of Fort Augustus settling on the Loch's southern shores.

We return to Edinburgh through the splendour of the "Monarch of the Glen country" and the Grampian mountains.

THE ISLE OF SKYE 3 DAY TOUR

Departs 09.00 **Returns 19.30 (Edinburgh)**
Departure days: Monday, Wednesday, Friday & Saturday (All year)
Accommodation options: B&B ensuite or Hotel (minimum 3 stars)

3 DAYS TO EXPLORE SOME OF THE MOST DRAMATIC AND BEAUTIFUL PLACES IN THE HIGHLANDS AND THE ROMANTIC ISLAND OF SKYE.

Highlights of the tour include Glencoe, the Lochaber region around Fort William, Eilean Donan Castle (set of "Highlander") and over the sea to Skye, where you stay in the picturesque harbour town of Portree.



The 2nd day focuses on exploring Skye.

Travel north to explore the Trotternish peninsula with its stunning Quiraing mountain pass and some of Skye's extraordinary geological scenery. Kilt Rock, composed of basalt columns (reminiscent of the pleats in a kilt) with its waterfall cascading over the cliffs and down into the sea below.

There will be a short break for lunch before continuing to enjoy this most dramatic of islands. Heading in a westerly direction there is Dunvegan castle, the ancestral home of Clan Macleod, and possibly, the opportunity to enjoy spectacular views at Neist Point, the furthest most west point on the island.



The 3rd day returns passing the Cuillin mountains to the mainland, through the 5 Sisters of Kintail, on to eerie Loch Ness, the central Highlands, Perthshire and Edinburgh.

IONA, MULL AND THE ISLE OF SKYE “FOUR ISLAND MAGIC” 3 DAY TOUR

Departs 09.00 Returns 19.30 (Edinburgh)
Departure days: Monday (April to October), Saturday (May to September)
Accommodation options: B&B ensuite or Hotel (minimum 3 stars)

5 DAYS TO ENJOY THE MAGIC OF THE ISLANDS OF MULL, IONA, STAFFA AND SKYE AND THE WILDERNESS OF THE WESTERN HIGHLANDS.

The 1st day's highlights include Loch Lomond National Park, Inveraray, seat of the Campbell clan, and the heart of the ancient Scots kingdom of Dalriada, before staying in the beautiful harbour town of Oban.



The 2nd day is an island adventure exploring the dramatic coastlines and sandy coves of Hebridean Mull and the peace and tranquility of Iona - birthplace of Celtic Christianity and traditional burial ground of Scottish Kings. It also gives you the option to take a boat trip to Staffa.

Day 3 takes you north along the west coast through Fort William, and the dramatic mountain scenery of the Five Sisters of Kintail to Eilean Donan Castle (set of “Highlander”) and over the sea to Skye, where you stay in the picturesque harbour town of Portree for 2 nights.

The 4th day focuses on exploring Skye including the wild north of the island, the old man of Storr, the mountain pass of the Quiraing and Skye's most westerly point at Neist.

The 5th day returns you through the Cuillin Mountains to the mainland through the 5 Sisters of Kintail, on to eerie Loch Ness, the central Highlands, Pitlochry and Edinburgh.



All ferry crossings (except Staffa) included. Day 2 is an early start because there is so much to see and do, so you might miss your breakfast!
